- Intensive engagement with block/district team to capitalize already mobilized CIs for effective implementation and monitoring of village plans
- Develop and roll out strategy to saturate the key social protection and relief schemes identified under VPRP-GPDP process as Entitlement Action Plans.
- Facilitate functional spaces for rural women and their collectives to take leadership and supervisory roles in scheme implementation & monitoring like Mahila Mates, CLF as PIA etc.
- Identification and documentation of best practices of SRLM
